### **COGGS - Local Watchdog for Community**

#### **Submission:**

CCOGS is a large community group of citizens who have come together. In light of many industries closing down in the Geelong area, COGGS is carefully watching how local and federal governments will ensure taxpayer dollars are spent carefully in the region to revitalise the Geelong area.

During our research and that of the Open Eye Institute, we have found that taxpayer money is being wasted in the medical sector. There are too many committees, sub committees and sub-sub committees where the same people are on boards and taxpayer funding is used and diluted instead of ending up on the frontline in our hospitals and dental clinics.

- For example, millions of tax payers' dollars are being spent on an outdated practise of Artificial Fluoridation instead of setting up free clinics for all school age children to teach them proper dental hygiene. If artificial water fluoridation worked, then after 60 years of treatment we should not have needed \$15M.aud to be given to Tasmania due to its dental crises, nor have any other dental crises.
